3. **Life Member:**

Nominations will be received by the Board who will recommend to the Annual General Meeting candidates eligible for election, (ONLY ONE MAY BE ELECTED). Life Membership nominations shall be signed by two Ordinary Members, but need not be endorsed by the Nominee.
