House Policy The Responsible Service of Alcohol

Responsible serving of alcohol is vital for legal, health and community reasons. Our society is now less tolerant of the irresponsible use of alcohol that leads to drunkenness, drink driving and under age drinking.

All members of Staff of this Club are trained in the Responsible Service of Alcohol and the guidelines, which form our house policy as set out below:

- We will not knowingly serve alcohol to underage patrons. Proof of age will be asked for if in doubt.
- If we are unsure if a patron is a Member, we will ask to see their Membership card or Temporary Members ticket. We will not serve anyone without proof.
- Persons entering these premises, who are deemed to be intoxicated will be politely refused entry.
- Sale of alcohol will be politely refused to those patrons deemed to be intoxicated.
- We support and actively promote initiatives to minimise drink driving in order to safeguard the wellbeing of our patrons.
- We do not accept or allow indecent, violent or quarrelsome behaviour.
- Anyone deemed by management to be outside these guidelines will be asked to leave the premises quickly and quietly.
- Police may be called for assistance if patron(s) in question refuse to leave.

Remember: The person you allow to drive a vehicle under the influence of alcohol could well be the person who causes the next fatality.
